INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE CAMPAIGN'S

Roses for the Virgin Mary.

Preparing for my Consecration.







CAMPAING'S THEME: Roses for the Virgin Mary, preparing for my Consecration.

DATE: 31 Days (we suggest the campaign to end on a Marian Feast Day).

SUGGESTED AGE RANGE: From 5 to 12 years old.


GENERAL OBJECTIVE: That the children console the Virgin Mary with their acts of love during 31 days, dedicated to Her.

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES:

- 1. That the children know the most important aspects of the life of the Virgin Mary.
- 2. Instil in children a greater love for the Virgin Mary with the roses that they will offer Her each day.
- 3. Propitiate moments of family gathering and prayer.
- 4. That the children may consecrate themselves to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary at the end of the campaign.

MATERIAL:


- 1. The instructions for the Campaign: this document.
- 2. Guide. In this document you can find the short reflections on the life of the Virgin Mary, the prayer and offering the children will do daily, which we will call: Rose of the Day.
- 3. Board: in this folder you will find a series of files that you will have to print at letter size, namely:
 - a. Board A in gray (01, 02, 03 and 04): these 4 boards will be the basis of the campaign to be carried out every day. Each one must be printed in letter size and joined together with tape to form the image shown here below:

b. Color board B (01, 02, 03 and 04): from this board the roses that are offered to the Virgin Mary will be cut out and glued to the gray board day by day. Thus, at the end of the month, the entire color board will be glued on top of the gray board, looking like this:



- 4. Consecration Prayers stamps.
- 5. Sheets of paper (letter size).
- 6. Scissors.
- 7. Tape.
- 8. Glue or printable adhesive paper.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Print the files "Board A (01, 02, 03, and 04)" and "Board B (01, 02, 03 and 04)".
- 2. In the morning, read with your child the short reflection on Mary's life contained in the Guide, which you can print out or read directly from your computer or cellular phone. Meditate on it for 2 minutes. Then proceed to the prayer; the children may add their own spontaneous prayer if they want to.
- 3. Then read the Rose of the Day, which is the offering the children will do to the Virgin Mary each day. If you consider it necessary, you may change the offering for something else you feel your child needs to work on: I will share my toys with my siblings, I will eat all the food on my plate, etc.
- 4. During the day, the children should perform the "Rose of the day".
- 5. At the end of the day or the time you define as a family, the child cuts the Rose of the Day from the Color Board B (01, 02, 03 or 04), and glues it on the gray Board A on the corresponding day.
- 6. On Day 31, the children are invited to attend Mass and consecrate themselves to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary through the consecration prayers hereby provided. It is recommended that this day coincide with a Marian festivity.
