On Thursday February 11th, once the preparation had taken place, Fr. José Fabián Camayo celebrated the Holy Mass of Consecration and Enthronement of the Mall and Office Towers of “Mansión Blanca” to the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary.

He reminded the attendees of the great life commitment that is acquired when receiving Our Blessed Lady of Guadalupe and Her Son Jesus as owners of each one of the aspects of the lives of the consecrated.

The owners of the different stores within the mall as well as representatives of the companies that have their offices there, participated in the Holy Mass with much devotion and were present when their premises were blessed.

On February 14th, the Mission together with committed laity from the Movement John XXIII, organized a small celebration for the grandparents of the Parish “La Merced”. They are elderly people who live in conditions of risk, many of them alone, in complete abandonment or in very precarious conditions.

The Mission visits them frequently, praying with them for their needs and keeping them company.

The celebration began with the Eucharist presided by Msgr. Miguel Ángel Aguilar who gave a message of comfort and encouragement to them.

Then the grandparents were invited to a small lunch and were given groceries that members of the Mission had donated.

The day ended with prayer and thanksgiving songs to Our Lady of Guadalupe and Her beloved Son Jesus Christ.

CELEBRATION WITH THE ‘GRANDPARENTS’ OF THE RURAL PARISH “LA MERCED”



The Ecuadorian Episcopal Conference invited all the Catholic faithful to the Great Patriot Jubilee of Mercy and the Celebration of the Eucharist of petition and thanksgiving to God for our country, which was held on Thursday, April 7th at 17 h 00 at the Basilica of Voto Nacional.

All the parishes of our Archdiocese, Catholic educational establishments, movements and social works were invited to participate in this celebration together with the Bishops of our country. Presided by Monsignor Fausto Trávez, Archbishop of Quito;

Primate of the Ecuador and President of the Episcopal Conference, who visibly touched, reminded the attendees that Ecuador was and is blessed by being the first country consecrated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary, and Monsignor René Coba, military Bishop, read the renewal of this consecration.

The Apostolic Nuncio Monsignor Giacomo Ottonello Pastorino, concelebrated and who along with the presence of many bishops and priests added solemnity to this important celebration in Ecuador.

PATRIO JUBILEE OF MERCY



On Sunday, May 29,th at 10 h 00 at the Metropolitan Cathedral, Monsignor Danilo Echeverría officiated Mass to celebrate Corpus Christi. Later the procession through the streets of the historical centre with the Blessed Sacrament towards the Basilica del Voto Nacional took place, and the blessing to the faithful was given.

Corpus Christi means "Body of Christ", with these words the Catholic Church refers to the Consecrated Host in the sacrifice of the Mass. Another way of referring to this great mystery of faith is "Eucharist", which in Greek means "Good grace". The Eucharist was instituted by Jesus at the Last Supper on Holy Thursday. The Catholic Church is since then, still celebrating it in obedience to the

words of the Savior: "Do this in remembrance of Me
Very early in the life of the Church, the common people began to worship in a special way the Body of Christ with a procession. From the year 1269 Pope Urban IV extended it to the Universal Church and arranged this celebration to be held the Sunday after the Feast of the Holy Trinity.

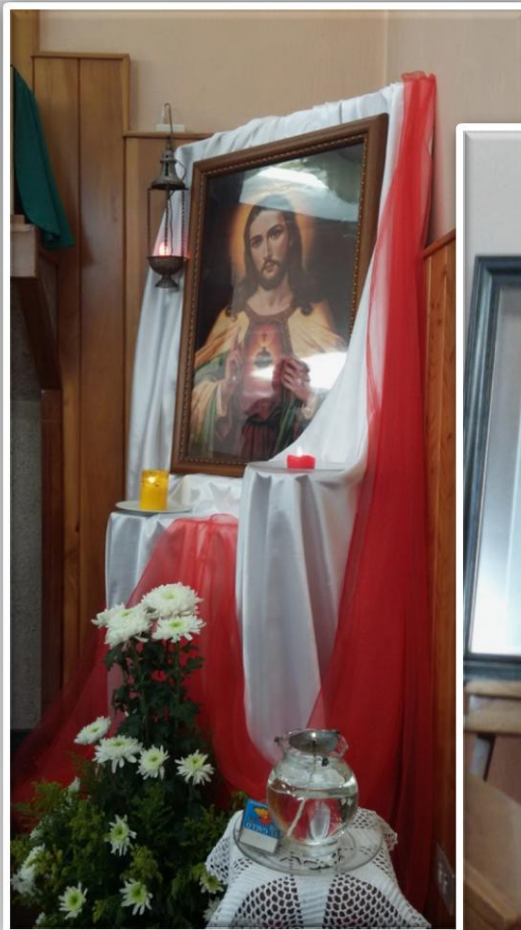

CORPUS CHRISTI





On Friday June 17th, the Sisters of Charity were consecrated to the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary. Fr. José Fabián Camayo celebrated a ceremony of thanksgiving and prayer for the health of the religious Sisters and they in turn placed all their work in favor of the less fortunate in the hands of the Holy Trinity, from Whom they implored their blessing for their efforts in the service of others. In the end Father blessed the dining that welcomes vulnerable children, adults and elders in that part of the city.

On Sunday June 19th, there was a procession and “romería” for the renewal of the Consecration of Ecuador to the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary, that went through the historic downtown of Quito: the Metropolitan Cathedral, the Government Palace, the Town Hall, the Archbishopric, and several important churches and convents in Quito. It was done praying the Holy Rosary for the intentions of the whole world and for peace in Ecuador.

The procession lasted 4 hours and a huge number of people participated with deep devotion.

Many youth groups from several schools as well as security groups marched singing songs in honor of the Sacred Hearts. 18 Bands of Peace from different schools in Quito participated.

The image of the Sacred Heart of Jesus was mounted in a fire truck and guarded by the Army, the National Police and the Municipal Band.

The Mission was in charge of the floral decorations for the cars that would carry the images of Jesus and Mary.

On Thursday June 23rd, the Mission was present in the blessing of the Chapel and the children's soup kitchen of Santa Inés with Msgr. Fausto Travez, Archbishop of Quito, and Fr. Emilio, parish priest of San Pedro Cumbayá.

During his homily, Msgr. Travez highlighted the devotion of the community and asked that they should seek God in their daily actions.

The image of Our Lady of Guadalupe will be present in the Chapel and soon She will be officially enthroned in the consecration of the community.
