1,200 faithful were consecrated in Ticuantepe

On July 12, 2015, parish priest Rafael O’Farril, along with 1,200 faithful from the town of Ticuantepe, gathered around on the grounds of the parish The Sacred Heart of Jesus, to celebrate the Confirmations of nearly 100 youngsters, Holy Mass and the Consecration to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. The day’s events were presided by His Eminence Cardinal Leopoldo

José Brenes. More than 1,500 people assisted after two months of preparation on all the subjects of Consecrations. The sessions were given by members of the Mission in Nicaragua in all of the 21 communities belonging to the town of Ticuantepe. The sessions began with four workshops directed to the coordinators of each community,

followed by personal visits of the Mission members to each community. The prayer of the Sorrowful Mysteries with the intentions of the Mission were strongly advised and were well embraced. Members of the national Media were present, including La Prensa, the newspaper with the highest circulation in the country and live transmission from Radio Católica.

El pasado domingo 12 de julio unas 1.200 personas se consagraron al Sagrado Corazón de Jesús y María, en la Parroquia Sagrado Corazón de Jesús, en Ticuantepe. Asimismo, alrededor de cien niños recibieron el sacramento de la confirmación, en una misa oficiada por el cardenal Leopoldo Brenes, la cual presidió el párroco de la iglesia, padre Rafael O'Farrill Bermúdez.

Estos tres sacramentos manifiestan la grandeza del corazón de Jesús. Todo el mes de junio lo consagramos a Él, con visitas a los hogares, la centralización de la imagen para que sea este el que domine en toda la familia", expresó el cardenal Brenes, quien además ofreció sus oraciones a los familiares de las víctimas de la tragedia del pasado sábado 11 de julio e hizo un llamado a meditar a la Policía Nacional, para evitar llenar de dolor a las familias nicaragüenses con esta clase de operativos.

La catequesis que recibieron los confirmados y la organización de la consagración estuvo a cargo de la asociación Misión por el Amor de Dios en todo el Mundo. "Somos una misión de fieles, una asociación de fieles católicos y lo que hacemos es trabajar de la mano con la Iglesia bajo su plan pastoral en cuatro pilares: la consagración, conversión, oración desde el corazón y las buenas obras", dijo Lorena César de Gutiérrez, directora nacional de la asociación, quien además expresó que "la consagración es una alianza que hacen, un cambio, una entrega al señor para que Él sea el dueño de toda tu vida".

"Estos son actos importantes de total entrega de nuestra vida al señor", expresaron algunos fieles consagrados, mientras los niños que recibieron la confirmación afirmaron que es un paso importante en el camino de fe que quieren seguir, de la mano de la Iglesia Católica.

Los 1.500 feligreses asistieron a la misa oficiada por el cardenal Leopoldo Brenes, en la Parroquia Sagrado Corazón de Jesús en Ticuantepe.

RELIC OF SAINT JOHN PAUL II IN NICARAGUA



On May 14, 2015, the Mission in Nicaragua had the honor to participate in guarding the first degree relic, non-coagulated blood of Saint John Paul II, in Matagalpa, for a day of prayer and veneration. The day began with Holy Eucharist at the Cathedral, presided by Monsignor Rolando Alvarez, Bishop of Matagalpa. Immediately after Mass, the members of the Mission were given the opportunity to venerate the relic. We then assisted in organising the faithful to come up to the altar to venerate the relic in an orderly fashion, during which time the Sorrowful Mysteries were prayed.

Once the event at Cathedral ended, we began the trip to the peak of the Mountain of Peace, where Fr. John Anthony Boughton, presented the relic to Our Lady of Guadalupe and led a prayer for the wellbeing of Nicaragua!
